Terms of Participation

50th Anniversary Harvest Fair • October 5 and 6, 2024

Application Process

All applications and fees must be received by **Thursday, September 5, 2024**. Please expect to hear from us two weeks after your completed application is received. We will provide fair logistics via email upon application approval and payment.

- Submitting this application and vendor fee payment does not guarantee acceptance as a vendor to Harvest Fair.
- Acceptance into Harvest Fair is reviewed each year and prior participation, in any capacity, does not guarantee acceptance as a vendor this year.
- Payments will be refunded via check if vendor is not accepted.
- NBS does not guarantee vendor exclusivity. We will encourage vendors to supply a variety of products but cannot ensure exclusivity for any vendor in attendance.

Vendor Space and Fees

Vendors may select a space for a Food Truck or "outside space" for vendors who use an open air or tent setup. Outside spaces will include one 8' table and two chairs. Vendors have the option to add-on half or one outside space. Please disclose on your application if you will be providing your own table(s) and chair(s).

Electricity is available for all vendors at a minimal fee. **Please note that WiFi will not be available.**

Early Bird Discount: Now through June 1, 2024, vendors will receive a \$25 Early Bird Discount on their total vendor space fee.

Vendor fees are not refundable for accepted vendors. In the event of a weather-related cancellation of both days of the fair, fees will be refunded.

Food Safety Regulations

Vendor agrees to follow Food Safety laws and regulations by complying with the following:

- Vendor must have a regulation-safe fire extinguisher.
- Vendor must keep cooking appliances along the outside perimeter of vending area.
- Vendor must keep area clean and free from contamination.
- Vendor must obtain and display license required by the Rhode Island Department of Health, Office of Food Protection.
- Vendors must obtain a MFE permit from the Middletown Town Clerk's office. P
- Vendor must hold a Certificate of Insurance (COI) listing the Norman Bird Sanctuary as the certificate holder.
- Vendor must hold a current sales tax permit OR must submit an Application for Temporary Retail Sales.

Sustainability

Please see our Sustainability Statement (enclosed). **In accordance with local ordinance, vendors are not allowed to use or package their items in plastic bags, sell beverages in plastic bottles, or distribute plastic straws.** Vendor should supply their own eco-friendly and/or compostable food service items. NBS will not supply "green" items to vendors. Vendor risks forfeiture of space without refund if they do not adhere to the Sustainability Statement.

Terms of Participation

50th Anniversary Harvest Fair • October 5 and 6, 2024

Sales Tax

All vendors must collect 7.00% Rhode Island sales tax on taxable items sold at Harvest Fair.

Vendors who do not hold an annual tax permit or exemption are responsible for contacting NBS to obtain an Application for a Temporary Retail Sales Permit and paying the \$10.00 application fee via check or money order made to the "Tax Administrator" by **September 5, 2024**. NBS will serve as a liaison to the State of Rhode Island and will collect applications, fee payments, and collected sales tax. At the conclusion of Harvest Fair, vendors will be required to submit collected sales tax to the Director of Finance and Operations at our Welcome Center immediately following the close of the event at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 6, 2024. If a vendor using the Temporary Retail Sales Permit does not collect and submit sales tax to the Director of Finance and Operations at the Welcome Center, NBS will report the vendor to the Division of Taxation and the vendor will not be invited to return to Harvest Fair or NBS as a vendor in any capacity.
