Terms of Participation

Harvest Fair • October 4 and 5, 2025

Crafter Eligibility

All crafts are subject to approval by the Harvest Fair Committee. The Harvest Fair Committee gives priority to original, handmade crafts and items using natural materials.

Non-eligible items:

- Imported, commercial, and mass-produced items, including all types of clothing, jewelry & accessories, home goods, food, art, toys, and pet accessories.
- Items made from endangered animals or plants, including ivory, scrimshaw, coral, and sea lavender.
- · Weapons, including knives and firearms.
- Products from multi-level marketing companies.

Vendor Booth and Fees

Vendors may select a booth space inside the Crafters Tent only. Booths will include one 8' table and two chairs. Vendors have the option to add-on half or one booth space. Please disclose on your application if you will be providing your own table(s) and chair(s).

Please note that WiFi will not be available.

Vendor fees are not refundable for accepted vendors. In the event of a weather-related cancellation of both days of the fair, fees will be refunded.

Application Process

All applications and fees must be received by **Friday**, **September 12**, **2025**. We will provide fair logistics upon application approval and payment.

- Submitting this application and vendor fee payment does not guarantee acceptance as a vendor to Harvest Fair.
- Acceptance into Harvest Fair is reviewed each year and prior participation, in any capacity, does not guarantee
 acceptance as a vendor this year.
- Payments will be refunded via check if vendor is not accepted.
- Vendors new to Harvest Fair: please submit photos of your craft with your application.

Sales Tax

All vendors must collect 7.00% Rhode Island sales tax on taxable items sold at Harvest Fair.

Vendors who do not hold an annual tax permit or exemption are responsible for contacting NBS to obtain an Application for a Temporary Retail Sales Permit by **September 12**, **2025**. NBS will serve as a liaison to the State of Rhode Island and will collect applications, fee payments, and collected sales tax. At the conclusion of Harvest Fair, vendors will be required to submit collected sales tax to the Director of Finance and Operations at our Welcome Center immediately following the close of the event at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 5, 2025. If a vendor using the Temporary Retail Sales Permit does not collect and submit sales tax to the Director of Finance and Operations at the Welcome Center, NBS will report the vendor to the Division of Taxation and the vendor will not be invited to return to Harvest Fair or NBS as a vendor in any capacity.

Application for Temporary Retail Sales Permit Exceptions: vendors who hold an RI Certificate of Exemption for Artistic Works and vendors who hold an annual tax permit.

Sustainability

Please see our Sustainability Statement (enclosed) to ensure your craft aligns with our mission. In accordance with local ordinance, vendors are not allowed to use or package their items in plastic bags. Vendors risk forfeiture of space without refund of vendor fees if they do not adhere to the Sustainability Statement.
